Please also bring your toiletries: toothbrush/toothpaste, soap, shampoo, & towel. Please note we will be sleeping in cabins on mattresses. Pray for the Holy Spirit to work in you to **bring** a heart and mind ready to receive God's Word.

THE GOAL of camp “Refine” is to encourage individuals to treasure Christ above all things (Phil 3:8.) Additionally, the goal is to instruct individuals on the importance of maintaining the true and proper vertical and horizontal relationships in their lives to fulfill God’s purpose of loving him and others. Our vertical relationship is between God and us. Christ has bled and died for us so we can have an eternal relationship with him. We must acknowledge that a relationship with him doesn’t mean that life becomes easy. We must trust in his sovereign control as he directs us. Now this relationship is foremost and needs to exist to make the proper horizontal relationships, which is our relationship with other believers within the Universal church, and non-believers. We often live in a society that is characterized by isolation and individualism. However, as believers we are called to stand together in unity and build one another up. Church is not simply a place to receive encouragement, but an assembly of people where we can contribute and be the church. Both of these relationships need to be *refined* by God’s Word, which was given to us so we can be built up, corrected, and encouraged (2 Tim 3:16). It is essential for us to receive discernment and wisdom from his Word so that we are not swayed by the numerous false teachings that are present today. We need refining so that our relationships between God and our relationship with the church align to God’s Word. We pray that God refines our hearts to the point that we can say that all things are worthless in comparison with knowing Christ. AMEN!

GUIDELINES TO ENSURE EVERYONE’S SATISFACTION

1. Positive attitude is mandatory. Bring it with you and you will enjoy your time at the camp.
2. Attend and participate in all events, including games, hikes, and most important worship/prayer services.
3. Quiet time is 11:00pm - 7:00am. Lights out at 11pm. No exceptions.
4. Leaving the campsite without permission of a camp leader is not allowed.
5. Do not bring any laptops or DVD players, Ipads, Tablets etc. They will be taken away until end of camp.
6. Bring a Bible, notepad and the desire to be equipped with the Word Of God.
7. Do not bring weapons, alcohol, drugs or any devices or substances that causes harm to your body, soul and spirit. If you are caught in possession with any of the above mentioned - you will be sent home and proper authorities will be notified.

CAMP DRESS CODE While having a pure heart and a clear conscience is more important than the clothes you wear at camp, we still like to encourage all campers to wear clothing that is suitable for a Christian Camp, especially when going swimming. Please do not bring clothing that reveal too much skin for that could be a stumbling block for others. For example: Ladies are to wear shorts (i.e. boarder shorts) when swimming. Guys, be modest and do not wear Speedos. In the kitchen, shirts, shorts and shoes are required at all times. Our goal is not to restrict or to police anyone but rather to promote a Christ-like attitude at all times. If the leaders or any of the staff deems that you are not following the dress code, you will be asked to change into appropriate clothing. We appreciate your cooperation in advance.

GROUPS AND GROUP ASSIGNMENTS All campers will be assigned into groups. All campers will sleep in the same cabin with their assigned groups. Each group will have to eat breakfast together, (lunch and dinner are optional). Throughout camp groups will be given assignments that they must complete as a group. (More info to follow once you sign up). All groups must participate in friendly competition for prizes.
